RESOLUTION NO. 6961 .

WHEREAS, presently there exists a situation which created by Sec. 1 of Article VI of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe which required that to qualify to vote in tribal election, the voter must be living in the community at least 90 days prior to the election day, and

WHEREAS, there are no voting districts established for each of the recognized communities listed under Sec. 2 of Article III of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe,

NOW THEREFORE, the Tribal Districting Committee of the Tribal Council moves the following resolution;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the boundaries of ANTELOPE community voting districts is hereby established to encompass the following described area;

Beginning in the SW corner of Lot 4, Section 21, T35N, R29W, thence north along section line and Crookston road, a distance of approx. 20 1/2 miles to the SE corner of the NE 1/4 of section 4, T38N, R29W., thence west approx. distance of 1/2 miles to the SW corner of the NE 1/4 of section 4, T33N, R29W, thence north crossing Rosebud-Mission road and Hiway 18, a approx . distance of 61/2 miles to the Todd County line, thence east along Todd County line to the NE corner of Section 3, T39N, R28W, a approx . distance of 7 1/2 miles, thence north into Mellette County along section line, a approx. distance of 2 miles, to the NW corner of section 26, T40N, R28W, thence east along section line, a distance of 1 mile, thence south, a distance of 2 miles to the Todd County line, thence east along Todd County line, a distance of 6 miles to the NE corner of section 2, T39N, R27W, thence south along the west boundary line of Okreek community voting district to the south boundary of Todd County line, thence west along Todd County and Nebraska line to the point tof beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that adult members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe living within the voting district are entitled to vote in the tribal or community election.

CERTIFICATION

We the undersigned hereby certify that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is composed of 21 voting members of whom 17 members constituting a quorum were present at a duly called and convened session of the Tribal Council held August 26, 1969 at Rosebud, South Dakota; that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the affirmative vote of 12 members, 2 opposed, and 3 not voting.
