

RESOLUTION NO. 6962 .

WHEREAS, presently there exists a situation which created by Sec.1 of Article VI of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe which required that to qualify to vote in tribal election, the voter must be living in the community at least 90 days prior to the election day, and

WHEREAS, there are not voting districts established for each of the recognized communities listed under Sec. 2 of Article III of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe,

NOW THEREFORE, the Tribal Districting Committee of the Tribal Council moves the following Resolution:


BE IT RESOLVED, that the boundaries of BAD NATION community voting districts is hereby established to encompass the following described area:


Beginning in the SE corner of Section 12, T42N, R25W, thence west along section line and the north boundary line of Butte Creek Community Voting District to the SW corner of Section 5, T42N, R27W, a distance of 16 miles, thence north along section line to the White River and Mellette County line, a approx distance of 8 miles, thence in a easterly direction along White River and Mellette County line and into Tripp County to the SE corner of Section 21, T103N, R77W, a approx distance of 25½ miles, thence south along section line and highway 183 to the SE corner of Section 11, T99N, R78W, a approx distance of 21 miles, thence west along section to the Mellette and Tripp County line to the point of beginning, a approx distance of 15 1/2 miles.

CERTIFICATION


We, the undersigned hereby certify that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is composed of 21 voting members of whom 17 members constituting a quorum were present at a duly called and convened session of the Tribal Council held August 26, 1969 at Rosebud, South Dakota, that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the affirmative vote of 12 members, 2 opposed, and 3 not voting.
