

RESOLUTION NO. 6963.

WHEREAS, presently there exists a situation which created by Sec. 1 of Article VI of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe which required that to qualify to vote in tribal election, the voter must be living in the community at least 90 days prior to the election day, and

WHEREAS, there are no voting districts established for each of the recognized communities listed under Sec. 2 of Article III of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe,

NOW THEREFORE, the Tribal Districting Committee of the Tribal Council moves the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the boundaries of BLACK PIPE community voting districts is hereby established to encompass the following described area;

Beginning in SE corner of section 31, T40N, R31W in Mellette County, thence west along Todd and Mellette County line, a approx. distance of 10 miles to the SW corner of section 35, T40N, R33W, thence south into Todd County along section line and county road, a distance of 3 miles to the SE corner of section 15, T39N, R33W, thence west 1 1/2 miles along section line and county road to the Todd County line, thence north Todd County line into Mellette County, a distance of 3 miles, thence continuing north along Mellette County line to the NW corner of Lot 1, section 22, T41N, R33W, thence east along section line, a approx. distance of 10 1/2 miles to the NE corner of section 20, T41N, R31W, thence south along section line and county road to the SE corner of section 18, T40N, R31W, a approx. distance of 6 1/2 miles, thence continuing south along section line to the Mellette and Todd County line and the point of beginning.

BE IT **FURTHER** RESOLVED, that adult members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe living within the voting district are entitled to vote in the tribal or community election/

CERTIFICATION

We, the undersigned hereby certify that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is composed of 21 voting members of whom 17 members constituting a quorum were present at a duly called and convened session of the Tribal Council held August 26, 1969 at Rosebud, South Dakota, that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the affirmative vote of 12 members, 2 opposed, and 3 not voting.
