

RESOLUTION NO. 6970.

WHEREAS, presently there exists a situation which created by Sec. 1 of Article VI of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe which required that to qualify to vote in tribal election, the voter must be living in the community at least 90 days prior to the election day, and

WHEREAS, there are no voting districts established for each of the recognized communities listed under Sec. 2 of Article III of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE, the Tribal Districting Committee of the Tribal Council moves the following Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the boundaries of IDEAL community voting districts is hereby established to encompass the following described area:

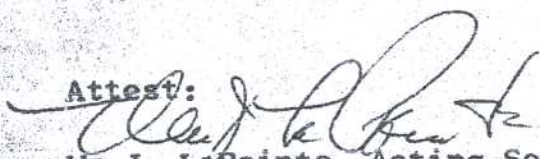
Beginning in the SE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, T99N, R76W, thence west along section line to the SW corner of Section 25, T99N, R78W, a approx distance of E $\frac{1}{2}$ miles, thence north to Highway 183, thence continuing north along highway 183 and east boundary of Bad Nation Community Voting District to the White River, a approx. distance of 24 miles, thence east along county line and the White River to the NE corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T103N, R76W, thence south along section line and Main Street in Winner, South Dakota, to the point of beginning, a approx. distance of 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles from the White River.

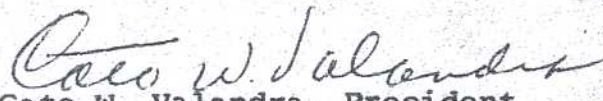
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that adult members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe living within the voting district are entitled to vote in the tribal or community elections.

CERTIFICATION

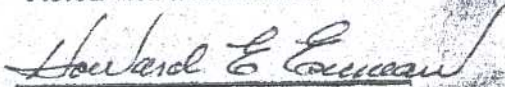
