## RESOLUTION NO.6975 .

WHEREAS, presently there exists a situation which created by Sec. 1 of Article VI of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe which required that to qualify to vote in tribal election, the voter must be living in the community at least 90 days prior to the election day, and

WHEREAS, there are no voting districts established for each of the recognized communities listed under Sec. 2 of Article III of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE, the Tribal Districting Committee of the Tribal Council moves the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the boundaries of ROSEBUD Community voting district is hereby established to encompass the following described area:

Beginning in the NW OF SW of SW of Section 18, T38N, R30W, on the Grass Mountain road, thence in a southwesterly direction along the Grass Mountain Road a approx distance of 1/2 mile to the south center of Section 13, T38N, R31W, thence west along section line and north boundary line of Grass Mountain community voting district and crossing the Little White River to the SW corner of Section 17, T38N, R31W. a approx distance of four miles, thence north one mile, thence east along section line and crossing Rosebud and Parmelee road to the SE corner of Section 12, T38N, R31W, a approx distance of 4 1/2 miles, thence north along section line to highway 18, approx distance of 2 miles, thence East along section line to the NW corner of section 2, T38N, R30W, a approx distance of 4 miles, thence north to highway 18 road, a approx distance of 4 miles, thence in a southeasterly direction along highway 18 to Rosebud and Highway 18 road junctions a approx distance of 5 miles, thence south a 1/2 mile in section 4, T38N, R29W, thence east a 1/2 mile thence south a 1/2 mile to the SE corner of Section 4, T38N, R29W, thence continuing south along section line and Crookston, Nebraska road and west boundary of Antelope community voting district to the SE corner of Section 4, T37N, R29W, a approx distance of 6 miles, thence in a northwesterly direction along the north boundary of Two Strike community voting district to the point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that adult members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe living within the voting district are entitled to vote in the tribal community elections.
