## RESOLUTION NO. 6976.

WHEREAS, presently there exists a situation which created by Sec. 1 of Article VI of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe which required that to qualify to vote in tribal election, the voter must be living in the community at least 90 days prior to the election day, and

WHEREAS, there are no voting districts established for each of the recognized communities listed under Sec. 2 of Article III of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe,

NOW THEREFORE, the Tribal Districting Committee of the Tribal Council moves the following Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the boundaries of SOLDIER CREEK community voting districts is hereby established to encompass the following described area:

Beginning in the SE corner of Section 34, T39N, R30W, thence west along section line and crossing Highway 18 to the SW corner of Section 31, T39N, R30W and approximate distance of four miles; thence north along Section line to Todd and Mellette counties line an approximate distance of six miles; thence east along Todd and Mellette county line to the Little White River an approximate distance of 4 1/4 miles; thence in a southwesterly direction along the Little White River to the northern part of Section 21, T39N, R30W an approximate distance of four miles; thence east along B.I.A. road to the NE corner of Section 22, T39N, R30W an approximate distance of 1 1/4 miles; thence south along section line and crossing Highway 18 to the point of beginning an approximate distance of 3 miles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that adult members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe living within the voting district are entitled to vote in the tribal or community election.

## CERTIFICATION

We, the undersigned hereby certify that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is composed of 21 voting members of whom 17 members constituting a quorum were present at a duly called and convened session of the Tribal Council held August 26, 1969 at Rosebud, South Dakota, that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the affirmative vote of 12 members, 2 opposed, and 3 not voting.
