RESOLUTION NO. 6977.

WHEREAS, presently there exists a situation which created by Sec. 1 of Article VI of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe which required that to qualify to vote in tribal election, the voter must be living in the community at least 90 days prior to the election day, and

WHEREAS, there are no voting districts established for each of the recognized communities listed under Sec. 2 of Article III of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe,

NOW THEREFORE, the Tribal Districting Committee of the Tribal Council moves the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the boundaries of SPRING CREEK community voting district is hereby established to encompass the following described area:

The south boundary line begins in the SE corner of Lot 1, Sec. 21, T35N, along Todd County line, a approx. distance of 13 1/2 miles, to the SW corner of Lot 2, Sec. 20, T35N, R33W, and beginning of the west boundary line, thence north along Todd County line a approx. distance of 11 miles, to the NW corner of Lot 1, Sec. 28, T37N, R33W, and beginning of north boundary line, thence east along section line, a approx. distance of 12 1/2 miles to the NE corner of section 28, T37N, R31W, and NW corner of St. Francis community voting district boundary thence south along west boundary of St. Francis community voting district line to point of beginning, a approx. distance of 12 miles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that adult members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe living within the voting district are entitled to vote in the tribal or community elections.

CERTIFICATION

We, the undersigned hereby certify that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is composed of 21 voting members of whom 17 members constituting a quorum were present at a duly called and convened session of the Tribal Council held August 26, 1969 at Rosebud, South Dakota, that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the affirmative vote of 12 members, 2 opposed, and 3 not voting.
