

RESOLUTION NO. 6978.

WHEREAS, presently there exists a situation which created by Sec. 1 of Article VI of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe which required that to qualify to vote in tribal election, the voter must be living in the community at least 90 days prior to the election day, and

WHEREAS, there are no voting districts established for each of the recognized communities listed under Sec. 2 of Article III of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe,

NOW THEREFORE, the Tribal Districting Committee of the Tribal Council moves the following Resolution:


BE IT RESOLVED, that the boundaries of ST. FRANCIS community voting districts is hereby established to encompass the following described area:

Beginning in SE corner of Lot 1, Section 20, T35N, R29W, and SW corner of Antelope Com. Voting District Boundary, thence west along Todd County line and Nebraska line, a distance of 11 miles to the SW corner of Lot 4, section 22, T25N, R31W, thence north along section line, and east boundary line of Spring Creek Voting District, a distance of 9 1/4 miles, to the NW corner of section 3, T36N, R31W, thence west along section line, a distance of 3/4 of a mile, thence north along section line, a distance of 2 miles, to the NW corner of Section 27, T37N, R31W, thence east along section line, a approx. distance of 3 3/4 miles, to the NE corner of section 30, T37N, R30W, and north of St. Francis, thence north 1 mile, thence east 1 mile, thence south 1 mile to the NE corner of section 29, T37N, R30W, thence east along section line, a distance of 7 miles to the NE corner of section 28, T37N, R29W, thence south along section line and Rosebud-Crockston road and West boundary line of Antelope Com. District to the point of beginning, a approx. distance of 11 1/4 miles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that adult members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe living within the voting district are entitled to vote in the tribal or community election.

CERTIFICATION

We, the undersigned hereby certify that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is composed of 21 voting members of whom 17 members constituting a quorum were present at a duly called and convened session of the Tribal Council held August 26, 1969 at Rosebud, South Dakota, that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the affirmative vote of 12 members, 2 opposed, and 3 not voting.
